A Symbols

Abort (through hemorrhage) (ark) - indicates one is seeking purification and healing of guilt from amoral acts and rejection of the life-giving aspect of the womb.

Abyss [ark] – an astral abyss trial. (Check dream symbols for level of abyss trial).

Accident (car) [ark] - payment of karma.

Accountant - one who works with the recording angel to track the payment of karma and grace.

Acorn - the acorn is symbolic of the fruits of strength, honesty and integrity.

Acrobatics (ark) - night flight techniques.

Adept (higher) - a higher adept in a dream would be represented as a sage, statesmen, painter, sculptor, writer, poet or composer.

Adversary - one who initiates or tests us with the forces of gravity; Satan.

Africa - tribal; primitive ethers and magics.

African Tribe (arck) - to dream of an African tribe in a dream means that one is working out tribal genesis energies or is reviewing the akashic record related to past life in tribal genesis.

African Violet - a healing for bigotry and prejudice; (IS) a symbol for Master R (Rakoczi): Ritual - Light Stream #7.

Air Conditioner (ark) - cooling off a heated situation; warning to not act impulsively.

Airplane - the higher etheric body. One is using his higher etheric body in the rarified etheric atmosphere of the higher dream veils.

Airplane (model) (ark) - model or blueprint of the higher etheric body.

Airplane (with passengers) - the higher etheric body traveling with a group of spiritual initiates in rare astral atmospheres.

Airline (pilot) - Master; earned grace from former life. Transport to higher regions of understanding.

Akasia - the pure, vitalized, supernal spiritual life-substance used by consciousness. The akasic light is soul-light. The color of akasia is indigo blue and is seen often in visions during meditation. Ether is the coagulating life substance. Prana is the energizing life substance in ether. Akasia substance is used in the highest form of spiritual telepathy. The more highly evolved one is, the more akasia he has in his mental and soul-light. One breathes in pranic energy to renew life force. One meditates to increase akasic light in his mind.

Akasia (IS) - The Cherubim Angels open the wisdoms in use of Akasia.

Akashic Records - records of former lives.

Agape-spiritual nourishment; food of the sacrament of the Lord's Table

Alaska - inner passage of the North; Salmon Bay.

Alcohol (rubbing) - to cleanse or disinfect.

Allergies - repression or rejection.

Alley - subconscious path leading to the family atom.

Alligator - initiation to overcome lust; or may pertain to some person with lustful attitudes.

Destructive, sentient, emotional will. Researching lust in one's own nature.

Aloe Vera - healing of overheated (rajasic) sexual energies. Service.

Altar - worship, devotion.

Altar (canopy or covering over the altar) - represents angelic insulation, protection, and support of a worship body's spiritual atmosphere from service to service.

Altar cloth (white) - represents spiritual ritual.

Altar cloth (creamy) - moves as spiritual ritual in the disciple's body.

Altar (dome over the altar at the end of a rectangular building) - pertains to man's immortality through the mediative power of his soul.ⁱⁱ

Altar (golden)(ark) - soul worship and devotion.

Altar (golden) - affects man's soul light.2

Aluminum foil (ark) - represents protection during a magnified cleansing.

Amber (color) - relates to the pranic flow of the life current. One sees the color of amber when he is researching the pranic life and light. To see a symbol diffused with amber indicates that it is a life symbol. The eye, either in dreaming or waking, when beholding the pranic color of amber, unites with the healing energies obtained from the life force.

Amber (jewel) - relates to healing etherically, or that is, the etheric counterpart of the organs in the physical body. Amber also relates to a degree of spiritual fire which cauterizes and purifies through spiritual healing.ⁱⁱⁱ Amber also relates to electromagnetism, pranic and etheric power.

Amber (bronze jewel)- bronze-amber relates to condensed pranic fire residing in the lower subconscious or lower quelle.

Amber (golden jewel) - light golden amber relates to purity of prana in the etheric body.

Amber Light (dove flying in) (IS) - Master Serapis: Order - Light Stream #3.

Amber Staff (IS) - Master Serapis: Order - Light Stream #3.

Amber Stone (IS) - Master Serapis: Order - Light Stream #3.

Ambulance (attendants) - angels.

Ambulance (burgundy) ark - the answer to karmic suffering caused by past life physical offenses.

Ambulance (white) - the answer to prayers.

Amethyst - Sacrifice, inoffensiveness, the healing of the impossibles, overcoming karma.

Amethyst stone (IS) - Master R (Rakoczi): Ritual - Light Stream #7.

Amulet-Talisman - atavistic, psychic powers. (Tribal priests understood symbology through atavistic, psychic powers. The talisman-amulets of ancient times were known by the priests and chiefs of tribes to hold potent magical power. Present-day amulet beliefs stem from tribal memories of primitive symbolic initiation passed down from one generation to another.) iv **Ancient of Days or Sanat Kumara (IS)** - all-seeing eye; golden chair; diamond staff; rainbow; throne.

Angels (Celestial) (IS) - golden harp; diamond.

Angels (Cherubim) - initiate man into the mathematical processes (geometrical symbols) in the use of mind plasmas or akasia. (IS) - cube; bar of music; musical sound heard in the inner ear; freshet poem; all great composers receive their musics through the help of the Cherubim Angels. All great cathedrals are built through the help of the Cherubim Angels. The Cherubim Angels are the master builders of heaven; protection; manifestors for building the unmanifested; sounders of the soundless into musics. The Cherubim Angels open the wisdoms in use of Akasia.

Angels (Seraphim) - initiate man into techniques of light, whereby he comes into contact with the archetypal ideas as given by the Christ Mind. Seraphim Angels lead the mind of man into the six dimensions or the door to the Third Heaven, where he is initiated by the Archangels in the archetypal light and the archetones under command of the Holy Ghost.

(IS) - six wings on the angel; many eyes making up a medallion; golden peacock's feather; crystal. Six-winged Seraphim symbologies have to do with ideas; the Lord of Mind or archetypal ideas research; an adept's vision.

Angels (Guardian) (IS) - perpetual flame; hearth; pure white hand; lesson in the mystery of space.

Angels (Recording) (IS) - book; scroll; golden chain; scales; lesson in timing.

Angels (Terrestrial) (IS) - vision of the sphere of the earth; upright tree; human heart; knowledge of gravity; bird.

Angles - yang. 3

Animal - to dream of an animal sometimes portrays, through the animal, the next step in evolvement and, thus, are prepared for certain transitions in their attitudes toward religion, family, sex and responsibility.

Animal (fighting or trapping) - one is being told in his dream that his initiatory action is now enabling him to overcome certain corresponding negative animal traits in his nature.

Animal (fleeing from) - one is being shown his penetrable point of fear, weakness and insecurity.

Animals (four footed) - represent the emotions, desires, feelings and senses.

Animal (hoofed (ark) - Pan influence. Means very heavy Capricorn or Sagittarius influence. Sexual initiation through Pan energies.

Animal (spiny) - aggressive, belligerent antagonist; one who is hypersensitive due to a guilty conscience.

Ankle - ankles are immersed in a horizontal energy zone of force consisting of the crosscurrents between astral magnetism and earth gravity. The ankles are the receivers and distributors of all polarity and duality forces, energies and powers. There are five types of Polarity Dwellers that can penetrate the etheric ankle axis: (1) Continent (2) Nation (3) City (4) Community (5) Environment. Polarity Dwellers can penetrate the etheric ankle axis of any person or disciple who has a specific spiritual work to do for the world. Such an attack occurs in rare instances of ripe timing and is part of the disciple's initiation previous to his dedication for a greater work directed toward a larger sphere of accomplishment.

Ankle (blow to) - subverted force is seeking to trip him so that he will lose this spiritual poise.

Ankle (breaking in dream) - a challenge by a subtle dweller seeking to overthrow his upright spiritual position. The spiritual aftereffects of such an initiation are equanimity, poise, self-assurance, confidence.

Ankle (broken) -martyrdom with persecution.

Ankle (fettered) - imprisoned, limited and restrained.

Ankle (injury) - if a person suffers an injury to his ankle or ankles, this is an indication of imbalance between the lesser etheric body and the emotional will, and also an imbalance between the emotional body and the thought. A prejudiced or faultfinding mind or lack of understanding as to justice in the world will cause a person to be subjectively prone to accidents to the ankles. In daytime action, when one suffers an accident to the ankle, he has opened himself to resisting forces of gravity. He is contending with these forces so that he may attain a greater degree of etheric range of flexibility and a broader etheric range of polarity action for the future.

Ankle (strong) - balanced and upright; true spiritual poise, has taken a stand, and will not be moved.

Ankles (standing water) - one has need of more courage, that he might move more deeply into the purifying waters, and thus experience the healing and cleansing of the pure rivers of life; indicates procrastination and timidity.

Antenna (ark) - sensory tool for sending and receiving telepathy.

Antique - an outmoded condition or relationship; also can be an object to open reincarnation memory.

Apartment (ark) - symbolic of a financial condition or situation.

Ape Man - dweller action, brute mind action, primitive instinctual nature

Apollo - sun; masculine principle of kundalini. Greek life together.

Apple - gravity. (Fruit may also be used as an allegorical symbol of temptation, or the eating of forbidden fruit and the gaining of forbidden knowledge.)

Apricot - a symbol of the first fruits, giving certain blessings in the month of the summer solstice.

Apron (white) (ark) - spiritual protection from indecisiveness due to karma.

Aquarian - Love thy neighbor as thyself; misuse of power.

Aquamarine - Aquarius - **high side** = correct use of will: (telepathic knowledge); **low side** = incorrect use of will: astral charged frenzy, fantasy and unreality.

Aqueduct (ark) - manmade stream of consciousness.

Arch (of foot) - one is being shown that he is ready to overcome a situation.

Archway (formed by two trees) (ark) - overcoming the blending of two archetypes.

Archangel Gabriel (IS) - horn; golden horn; red rose; ruby; infant child holding the hand of a man; the Madonna.

Archangel Michael (IS) - golden flaming sword; armor and breastplate; scales; diamond.

Archangel Raphael (IS) - white horse; white rose; rising sun; sapphire.

Archangel Uriel (IS) - aurora borealis; emerald; tree upside down (archetype of humanity generation).

Archetone - the Word under command of the Holy Spirit used in conjunction with all great archetypes. When the archetone sounds, the archetype comes alive with whatever compulsion is ripe or ready to be manifested. Thus, an archetype remains dormant until the archetone sounds. The Holy Ghost working with the Will of God sounds the archetone, that the great ideas or new impulse for man may enter the world or fall into the mind of man in timing to the Will of God. Archetype - original or divine blueprint for the mind and life processes in the earth. The greater archetypes work first as the unmanifest or as the Word yet to be made flesh. These spiritual, creative, divine archetype is an archetone. The Holy Spirit sounds within the archetone when the divine Word is ready to enter into the mind and life of man.

Ark - represents the archetypes.⁴

Ark of the Covenant (ark) - represents an archetypal covenant.

Arm (amputated) (ark) - the person whose arm has been amputated is being shown that henceforth he must progress in spite of some handicap to his initiative.

Arm (branded) (234) - should one dream that he is being branded on one of his arms, it indicates that he has exposed himself to malicious undercurrents of the psychic underworld.

Arm (holding someone) (233) - when one feels he is holding someone in the shelter of his arm, he has received tenderness grace, and henceforth becomes a shelter for those who are weary or burdened.

Arm (left) (ark) - to see the left arm in a dream signifies one is discerning their psychic initiative and power.

Arm (right) (ark) - to see the right arm in a dream signifies one is discerning his initiative to spiritualization the mind with the heart.

Arm (snake bite) (234) - should one dream that he is being bitten by snake on one of his arms, it indicates that he has exposed himself to malicious undercurrents of the psychic underworld.

Arm (tattooed) (234) - should one dream that he is being tattooed on one of his arms, it indicates

that he has exposed himself to malicious undercurrents of the psychic underworld.

Arm (vaccinated) (234) - should one dream that he is being vaccinated on one of his arms, it indicates that he has exposed himself to malicious undercurrents of the psychic underworld.

Arm (veined opened) (234) - to dream one is having a veined opened and sees a flow of blood, this indicates the loss of a blood relative.

Arm (with golden rainbow luminescent skin) (ark) one is seeing the vibrational life existing in one's nature at the level of soul power, grace, and memory; enlightenment.

Arm (wound) (234) - one has met an adversary who sought to take away from him his initiative.

Arm (wounded by adversary) (234) - to meet an adversary who wounds or bruises the arms indicates that one is to meet an adversary seeking to take away from him his initiative.

Armoire (ark) - a mobile but hidden aspect of the self.

Arms (athletic activity) (234) - the use of the arms emphasized in a dream indicates that one is preparing himself for crises or perils ahead.

Arms (embracing a person tenderly) (234) - should one embrace a person tenderly in his arms while dreaming, this reveals to the dreamer that he has attained the reverent side of love.

Arms (embracing passionately) (233-4) - one is experiencing an evaluation of his sexual desires and love intent.

Arms (holding a creature) (233) - should one hold a creature, an animal, tenderly in his arms, he is emulating the Lord Jesus.

Arms (lifted in supplication) (233) - one has surrendered his Will to God, and henceforth will be initiated into laws of obedience.

Arms (outstretched horizontally) (233) - symbol that one is to offer himself up as a supreme sacrifice and will there-after take upon himself the griefs and wounds of others.

Arms (swimming vigorously) (234) - if one is swimming vigorously with a rhythmic stroke, this reveals that he has mastered the astral currents and is a true swimmer in the spiritual sea of life.

Armor and Breastplate (IS) - Archangel Gabriel.

Arnica - for fear centered in the emotions, affecting the muscles.

Arrested (ark) - to be arrested by a policeman as a lawbreaker means one has offended the laws of God and is now confronting the payment of his physical karma in his physical life.

Art - associated with God's creativity. Access to higher levels of consciousness.

Arteries (including pulse points of the body, heartbeat, cells, veins, nerves, muscles, glands,

organs) (234) - etheric energy in the lesser etheric body.

Aurora Borealis (IS) - Archangel Uriel.

Ant or Ants - initiatory health experience. Bacterial disarrangement in the physical body. Imbalance of health or fever. Predictive of a sickness to be for self or some person or persons close by. Prediction of a mass epidemic.

Ants (large) - malignancy gone wild.

Ants (tiny) - a persistent fever.

Ape - malice. Unintelligible atavistic force. Sometimes seen before a tribal-genesis dweller experience or sentient emotional initiation. Brute force. Research into one's own aggressions and cruelty.

Ape man - dweller action; brute mind action; primitive instinctual nature.

Ash - fiery trial.

Aspirin - thinning of the ego.

Astral Self-Evaluation Initiations (49) - all persons who would serve as mediators for the Invisible Worlds must first undergo 49 self-evaluation initiations. These initiatory trials consist of [the first phase:] the moon's reflected sphere initiations which pertain to the three lower planes of the astral world (grotesque, fantasy, wish). The second phase of self-evaluation trials relates to Saturn's reflected sphere, where the initiate works with Sanat Kumara [Ancient of Days]. Here he may read the archaic records of mankind's history and trials in earth. When one is being initiated for Saturn's reflected sphere, he must cross the abyss between the third and fourth astral planes. This is a ring of darkness; and, because he has yet to qualify for unrestrained night-flight, he must be assisted over this abyss by the angels. The third phase of the self-evaluation trials relate to the higher astral world [8th sphere], where dwell the Saints and Buddha.

Astro Turf (green)(ark) - artificial or manmade healing nourishment.

Attic - relates to one's pride and also to hidden resources yet to be seen, stemming from the soulpowers.

Attorney (ark) - in a dream, one who works with the law on the inner planes.

Autumn - a necessity to re-evaluate one's attitudes and thoughts.

Avatar - an archetype; a deity who has come to earth in animal or physical form.

Avocado - healing oil of the spirit. The avocado is the feminine fruit of the East and relates to the Mary Principle. Its oily texture signifies the oil of healing peace through tender, anointing love.

Awning (ark) - protection.
