Hair - virility.

Hair (angelic) - filled with pranic light. To see angelic hair in a dream is to receive a blessing of vitality.

Hair (artificial) - hair arranged artificially in dreams symbolizes vanity and self-love.

Hair (auburn) - higher self-genesis.

Hair (balding) - when one sees the balding head of the aged, he is being shown that he is preparing to come under the tutelage of longevity wisdom, and should thereby develop prudence, character, faithfulness, veracity.

Hair (beard) (ark) - insight, wisdom.

Hair (black) - Tribal genesis.

Hair (black, wiry, bristling) - in a dream means one is receiving tribal-genesis knowledge. He will thereafter better understand the origin of tribal genesis. Extreme primal-fired psychic energy is used by such persons.

Hair (blond) - seen on a male by a woman dreamer indicates a messenger from God. Appearing on a woman to a male dreamer indicates the temptress.

Hair (blond) healthy - indicates fearlessness, warlike traits; also a super sensitivity to pride.

Hair (blond flowing on woman) - one is beholding the temptress and should prepare for a sexual trial.

Hair (blond platinum) (ark) - a secret agent from inner space; one who works with the Christ Mind.

Hair (blond strawberry) (ark) - higher self-genesis messenger from God.

Hair (braided) - hair braided in many braids indicates overzealousness.

Hair (brown) - self-genesis.

Hair (brown w/ tints of golden light) - symbol of a highly evolved humanitarian.

Hair (course) - indicates hostility and aggressiveness; malformation of the lesser etheric body.

Hair (course face hair) (ark) - indicates hostile and aggressive countenance.

Hair (cut or shaven) - if the hair is being cut or shaven, this is a symbol of sacrifice, renunciation.

Hair (cut or shaven) - if the hair is being cut or shaven, this is a symbol of sacrifice,

renunciation.

Hair (dyed blond on woman) (ark) - indicates one is under the tutelage of a warrior that has super sensitivity to pride.

Hair (loose curls) - indicates one has a sense of humor.

Hair (w/curlers) (ark) - one is making an effort to have a sense of humor.

Hair (tight curls) (ark) - one is wound up tight.

Hair (dry, listless, unhealthy) - symbol that the lesser etheric body is demagnetized and cannot regenerate itself during sleep. Indicates over-timidity and hypersensitivity and malformation of the lesser etheric body.

Hair (dyed fiery red w/orange tones) - symbol that the person is under the tutelage of astral subverted powers.

Hair (gray) - if one sees his own hair graying, or the hair of another person graying, it is the symbol that time is running out, and that one must hasten to keep pace with the soul's demands.

Hair (low on forehead) - to dream of one having hair too low on the forehead indicates one is to receive a mental shock or some restraint upon his imaginative faculties; also indicates tribal genesis faculties.

Hair (luxuriant) - indicates good health of the lesser etheric body.

Hair (luxuriant on skin) - luxuriant hair on the skin seen in a dream indicates tribal-genesis tendencies in the person seen.

Hair (matted) - indicative of laziness, unreliability.

Hair (orange) - an astral elemental color.

Hair (oily) - symbol of a cunning mind; one is seeing a person with a large body who desires to force himself through small openings. Indicates stubbornness. Indicates malformation of the lesser etheric body.

Hair (ponytail) (ark) - restraint. (See color for insight on what is being restrained).

Hair (texture) - to observe the hair texture, thickness, color in a dream, one is seeing a person who lives in the earth. He may determine what sort of person he is seeing by the vitality within the hair. Should one perceive a woman with flowing blonde hair or with titan red hair, one is beholding the temptress, and should prepare for a sexual trial.

Hair (over-thick) - indicates malformation of the lesser etheric body.

Hair (short) (ark) - one is under sacrifice or renunciation.

Hair (thick) - thick head of hair upon a person in a dream indicates that the one seen has a healthy lesser etheric body, or one who is immune to certain physical weaknesses or depletions.

Hair (thin) - a sign of the onset of illness.

Hair (titan) - astral tendencies in a racially aware person.

Hair (touching) - when one touches a vibrant lock or head of hair in a dream, he receives a transfusion of etheric fire into his own lesser etheric body.

Hair (vermin in) - indicates fevers of an infectious or contagious nature. Also, the symbol of procrastination, licentiousness and amorality.

Hair (washing) - reveals that one is cleansing the lesser etheric body, thus relaxing and neutralizing static etheric energy.

Hair (weird, wild, uncombed) - weird hair styles are seen on astral forms in the night, such as wild, uncombed tresses.

Hair (white) (ark) - an indication of spiritual vibrancy.

Hair (wig) - if one is seen wearing a wig this is a symbol that he has two personalities; one he knows himself to be, and the other is a deliberate affectation or the desire to conceal something of himself.

Hair (wig with loose curls) (ark) - wearing a wig in a dream symbolizes that he has two personalities; one he knows himself to be, the other is a deliberate affectation of having a sense of humor.

Hairdresser (ark) - to dream that you are a hairdresser, suggests that you are imposing your ideas and opinions on others.

Hallway - transition.

Hammer (carpenter's) (343) - a carpenter's hammer represents Joseph, the father of Jesus.

Hammer (household) (343) - a household hammer represents the need to correct a neglected family situation.

Hammer (pounding) (343) - in a dream, to be using a hammer for pounding—as on an anvil—is to be shaping and molding one's own aggressiveness into pliability.

Handcuffed (ark) - detained due to karma.

Handkerchief - healing; magnetic vehicle for healing the impossibles.

Handkerchief (white) - spiritual dreamer will have small miracles of healing.

Hand (healing) (IS) - Jesus: Healing - Light Stream #6.

Hand (pure white) (IS) - Guardian Angel.

Hand (right amputated) (ark) - if it is one's own limb, one is being shown that henceforth he must progress in spite of some handicap to his initiative on the path of the Masters; if it is the limb of a person known to you or a symbol related to another, you are being shown this about them.

Hand (left hand) (ark) - the path of the mystic; the feminine polarity. *Negative connotation:* represents the dark path

Hand (right hand) (ark) - the path of the Masters, the masculine polarity; Heavenly Father; the law, the heart.

Hand (shaking the Master's hand) (IS) - to the shake the Master's hand in a dream is to be accepted as a probationer; to make a covenant to accept one's karmic cleansing and thereby render a service to aid in the soul liberation of others.

Hands (ark) – hands in a dream represent exploration.

Hands (amputated) - the person whose hands have been amputated is being shown that henceforth he must progress in spite of some handicap in his exploration of the Dharma (sacred instruction).

Hands (touching) ark – touching something in a dream indicates one is being trained as to sensitivity in touch.

Hands (clapping)(ark) - stimulation of the eternal center in the gleaming brain at the crown of the head.

Hands (clenched left fist) - in a dream or vision indicates a threat.

Hands (clenched right fist) - a need for firmness and a promise of protection.

Hands (10 fingers) - relate to the Zodiacal Overlords or Heavenly Hosts. The hands and the ten fingers are the symbols of the Great Law or the Dharma.¹

Hands (fingers):

- ***Fingers (index)*** - the influence finger.
- ***Fingers (left index)*** - danger of submission to hypnotic influence from the astral guru level or from some psychical person using hypnotic powers.
- ***Fingers (left index of another person)*** - indicates the danger of submission to hypnotic

influence from the astral guru level or from some psychical person using hypnotic powers.

- ***Fingers (left index of one's own hand)*** - one is being shown that he is using the hypnotic will to nullify the will of another person.
- ***Finger (right index)*** - one is being given assurance that he is under guidance, and that he is preparing to learn true discrimination.
- ***Finger (left marriage finger)*** - relates to physical partnership lessons. To dream of a ring upon the left-hand marriage finger means that one has made an agreement to walk the left-hand path.
- ***Finger (right marriage finger)*** - relates to spiritual initiation, or spiritual marriage between the soul and the spirit; seeing a ring on the marriage finger indicates spiritual initiation. A gold ring indicates spiritual initiation and soul grace. A diamond ring indicates one is being initiated into the logos of the higher self and into the eternal medallion surrounding the higher self.
- ***Fingers (middle)*** - mentality finger.
- ***Fingers (left middle)*** - one is using the negative side of his intellect.
- ***Fingers (left middle of another person)*** - this denotes that one is exposed to the untrained thoughts of the person, or that he is receiving negative telepathies from an inverted source.
- ***Finger (right middle)*** - indicates that one is using his mental faculties on a higher level, or that his thoughts are approved by the Heavenly Presences.
- ***Fingers (thumb)*** - authority finger.
- ***Fingers (left thumb)*** - when seen in a dream indicates force, aggression, dominance, tyranny.
- ***Fingers (right thumb)*** - *one* is being initiated into the higher will, and therefore will receive certain lessons relating to the modification in the use of the will; and in time will attain spiritual authority.

Hands (healing hands) - when placed upon an ailing organ or a weakened part of the body, this is the symbolic that one is receiving heavenly, invisible healing helps.

Hands (in tight fist) - hands closed into a tight fist are as a closed bud of a lotus or the

unmanifested Dharma.²

Hand (opened) - an open hand facing one is the symbol of blessing, giving, serving, healing.³

Hands (outstretched) - to see the outstretched palms of both hands in a dream or vision indicates one's surrender, and his recognition of his own helplessness.

Hands (palms) - The nervous system in the palm of the hand works directly with the Gleaming Brain. The palm of the hand is one of the great centers of the Eternals.⁴

Hands (praying) - the symbol of intercession from the higher worlds.

Hands (touching) - see *Touching*.

Hanuman - the *higher side* or more kindly aspect of the monkey symbol, seen when one is undergoing purification of the sexual or second chakra, one contacts the greater myth-symbols and dramas of the monkey god, *Hanuman*. This symbol indicates that one should render service to God and become a householder karma-yogi or yogini. Sexual purity in the family environment comes when one dedicates his family experience in blood kin or brotherhood as a selfless service for God.

Harbor (ark) - a resting place for a sanctuary or an environment as a means to a spiritual way of life.

Harp (golden) (IS) - Celestial Angel.

Hat (337) – the teacher. *The person with a hat in a dream means that one has a teacher. A teacher with the hat off the head means that one is not at home with the teacher. The hat eventually becomes the umbrella of the Great Master Bhraspati who gives the light of the Christ and reveals to you how to be lead and to maintain yourself.*⁵

Hat (beige fisherman's hat) (ark) - a non-involved or neutral teacher as a fisherman for the Christ.

Hat (beret - green) (ark) - a teacher of peace and healing; a spiritual teacher's first instruction.

Hat (beret - white) (ark) - spiritual teacher.

Hat (beret - white with silver sequins) (ark) - spiritual teacher acting as a mediator.

Hat (bicycle helmet) white (ark) - spiritual teacher in the use of the lesser will.

Hat (black) (337) - a dark guru.

Hat (black and brown fur) (ark) - an aggressive and belligerent teacher who receives a karmic penalty.

Hat (black hood) - a dark guru or teacher who works with the dark forces and/or elemental magics.

Hat (black turban) (ark) - a dark eastern guru who works with the dark forces and/or elemental magics.

Hat (bowl-shaped) dark blue (ark) - a Saturn-ruled teacher of purification through discipline; indicates a slowdown of evolvment.

Hat (bowl-shaped) white (ark) - spiritual purification teacher.

Hat (brownish red) (ark) - karmic teacher.

Hat (cowboy) (ark) - western teacher.

Hat (dark blue) - one who teaches discipline of the thoughts.

Hat (metal helmet) (ark) - teacher of mental disciplines; a warrior. (Note type of metal for deeper meaning).

Hat (Leprechaun) (ark) - teacher of elemental magic.

Hat (low on forehead) - indicative of some restraint on one's authority related to teaching and physical satisfaction or recognition of one's services.

Hat (off the head) - a teacher with the hat off the head means that one is not at home with the teacher.⁶

Hat (party) (ark) - a teacher of a conclave of initiates.

Hat (red) (ark) - cosmic teacher.

Hat (royal blue) (ark) - a teacher's blessing and a promise of substance and expansion

Hat (Santa Claus) (ark) - Christ Jesus Teacher.

Hat (Safari) (ark) - astral teacher or teacher of the subconscious.

Hat (tent) (ark) – a temporary teacher.

Hat (tribal) (ark) - tribal genesis teacher.

Hat (turban) (ark) - an eastern teacher.

Hawk - a deliberate destroyer; one who searches for his prey with unremitting persistence; a

clairvoyant using his powers without mercy.

Head (back of) - to dream of seeing *the back of a person's head* or the back of several heads, means the end of one's association with them, or of a refusal of the one seen to acknowledge him as an ego or person. When only *the back of the head of a Master is seen*, one is being rejected by the Master.

Head (balding) - when one sees the balding head of the aged, he is being shown that he is preparing to come under the tutelage of longevity wisdom, and should thereby develop prudence, character, faithfulness, veracity.

Head (blow to) - lust.

Head (band or ribbon on forehead) - symbol of restraint due to authority.

Head (falling on) - humiliation lesson caused by lust.

Head (separated from body) - former life execution memory.

Heads (touching) (ark) - united and acting with one mind.

Healing - begins in praising.

Healing (hand) (IS) - Jesus: Healing - Light Stream #6.

Heart (274-5) - the heart is an initiatory organ of love. To be aware of the heart as an organ of the physical body in the night indicates that one should search his physical tensions and relate himself to his karma as to love or his gratitude-attitudes toward love.

Heart (ark) - inner temple.

Heart (shot in heart) (275) - to be shot in the heart by a fellow disciple in a dream means that the fellow initiate was used as a karmic pawn endangering his spiritual life. It is grace when one had a dream forewarning of obstacles being placed on the path of evolvment.

Heart (human) (IS) - Terrestrial Angel.

Heart (pain) (275) - to dream of pain in the heart indicates one is involved in emotional struggle so that he may open the corridors of the heart.

Heartbeat (including pulse points of the body, cells, veins, nerves, arteries, muscles, glands, organs) (234) - etheric energy in the lesser etheric body.

Hearth - the hearth in the house indicates the Guardian Angel watching over the house.

Hearth (fire on the hearth) - indicates that the life in the body, or the house, is functioning as a living force.

Heaven (2nd) (dc) - Hall of Wisdom. This is where we learn about the planets. The Masters work

on this plane.

Hedge (allegory used by planetary angels) - is the symbol of the time factor through which man creates. The hedge imposes certain restraints by the law of cause and effect; a law put upon each man-made thing, i.e., the establishment of laws to protect man from self-destruction (323).

Hedge - protection; if one is inside the hedge, it means negative limitation.

Hedge (of dried brush) - indicates the end or termination of a cultivated and insulated environment that was necessary to one's state of evolvement.

Hedge (of vine or plants) - indicates that one has a cultivated and insulated environment necessary to his present state of evolvement.

Herb/Seeds - all herbs and seeds are expanders of the selective palate. In the refinement and sensitivity developed in the spiritual life, one must give heed to the selective palate guiding him to the true and pure resources of live-giving vitalities supporting his spiritual life.

Helicopter - higher etheric body with limited etheric night flight still held to gravity through an over materialistic nature.

Helmet (metal) (ark) - teacher of mental disciplines; a warrior. (Note type of metal for deeper meaning).

Helmet (white bicycle) (ark) - spiritual teacher regarding use of the lesser will.

Higher Etheric Body - does not have pinions or wings. Night flight is experienced as a form of spiraling flight. Thus, the initiated speak of the higher dream veils as night flight.

Higher self - the eternal reality telepathies.

Highway – see Freeway.

Hill - high place of exaltation; indicates a necessity to climb and to make an effort on the path.

Hill (going backwards up a hill) (ark) - reversing or undoing one's efforts on the path leading to place of exaltation.

Hippocrates' Symbol (serpent on a cross) (IS) - Master K.H. (Koot Hoomi): Law - Light Stream #4.

Hip (w/band or belt) (276) - any sort of *wearing apparel of ancient times*, such as a chastity belt, indicates that one is in danger of amoral action in sex. The higher side of such a dream if the belt is worn by a woman indicates that she has worn a chastity belt in former times.

Hip (drape around it) (276) - (similar to Jesus drape in His crucifixion) symbol of renunciation, sacrifice, suffering, pain, humility.

Hip / thigh (276) - any form of restraining fabric placed upon the hips or thighs of a man or woman is a symbol that one is being taught to raise the primitive fire of the will at the base of the spine and the pelvic center into the spiritual fire or akasia.

Hip / thigh (276) - the second axis polarity of the body, are the symbol of poise, equanimity, and are the symbol of the sexual and personal will.

Hip / thigh (balanced, rhythmically proportioned) (276) - indicates that one has come into a degree of self-control. (The center of self-control is at the base of the spine.) Through effortless movement in walking, one comes to understand the etheric forces and currents. Etheric of free vitality walking during the day is the result of the etheric release received in the night-flight action.

Hip / thigh (surgery) (ark) - surgery upon the hip or thigh is a symbol that one is being freed from lack of self-control over his sexual and personal will in order to gain poise and equanimity.

Hip / thigh (touched) (275) - to dream that one is being touched on the hips or thighs (as in the story of Jacob wrestling with the dweller, or his initiatory contestant) is the symbol that one is being tried for higher degrees of genesis and should be prepared for the coming genesis initiatory trials.

Hippopotamus - represents polarity of the sexual nature in the second chakra.

Hippopotamus (lower aspect) - of the hippopotamus symbolizes motherhood abuse, or possessiveness in motherhood.

Hippopotamus (higher aspect) - the midwife or Divine Mother giving birth to the child of the soul - the higher self.

Holy Ghost (IS) - breath in a vision or dream.

Holy Man (ark) - God Realized man, a Master.

Home - desire for protection.ⁱ

Honey - for healing of the etheric body; strengthens the solar energy within the lower etheric body.

Honeydew Melon - symbol of rewards.

Hook (metal fisherman's) (ark) - a fisherman of men; a follower of Jesus.

Hook on the wall (ark) - a resting place which provides insulation.

Horizontal (dc)- things of the world.

Horizontal bar - magnetic currents of astral world; astral construction; emotional indecision;

opposition from persons; animal kingdom.

Horn (IS) - Archangel Gabriel.

Horn (conch) - conch sound indicates summoning of the Host.

Horn (empty) - one must yet earn to secure prosperity.

Horn (golden) (IS) - Archangel Gabriel.

Horns of Moses - represents power through the law and vision.⁷

Horn (overflowing) - a horn overflowing indicates bountifulness, a cornucopia.

Horse - progress.

Horse (black) - symbolizes dark, magical psychic powers.⁸

Horse (bay) - slow but safe conduct.

Horse (brown) - material progress.

Horse (mare) - a domestic burden-bearer; progress of a domestic nature; a woman fulfilling her duties to children and mate.

Horse (Percheron) - a steady uncomplaining helper; enslavement to conformity.

Horse (old white pony) (arck) - represents past child's play; or past self-delusion as to spiritual progress.

Horse (pony) (154) - represents child's play; or self-delusion as to progress.

Horse (red roan) - symbolizes unruly psychic powers.⁹

Horse (with rider) (ark) - an initiate leading one to progress. (*See surrounding symbols for identification of rider and type of progress.*)

Horse (red roan) - symbolize unruly psychic powers.¹⁰

Horse (roan) - a symbol of one who is caught into traditional concepts interfering with spiritual progress; one who is self-satisfied with his progress; an over complacent person.

Horse (sacrificial) - a sign of freeing and progression.

Horse (saddle) (ark) - to see the saddle of a horse means one is being restrained in their progress.

Horse (saddle horn) (ark) - to see the saddle horn in a dream means that one's prosperity is being

restrained.

Horse (stallion) - a sexual challenge, and a warning to be more reverent in attitudes toward procreation.

Horse (white) - spiritual progress and evolvment; an avatar and a teacher; usually seen at Easter; **(IS)** - Archangel Raphael.

Horse (white pony) (arck) - represents child's play; or self-delusion as to spiritual progress.

Horse (white stallion) - *the white stallion so often seen in preparatory instruction represents the last phase of discipline in taming and transposing the psychic force in the spiritual.*¹¹

Horseshoe (ark) - symbolizes success and prosperity flowing into your life through a grace opening.

Horseshoe (pointing down) (154) - magnetism from a person on earth and from one's own emotions.

Horseshoe (pointing up) (154) - holy magnetism received from heaven.

Hospital - research into the night in the precincts of healing. Indicates that one is preparing to be a night server or healer in the night. Can also be prophetic symbol relating to one's own care for the body.

Hostage (ark) - powerless victim.

Hotel / Motel - a symbol of transit or temporary state of consciousness; indicates that one feels disoriented and displaced.

Hourglass (IS) - Master M (El Morya): Will - Light Stream #1.

House - a house with a pleasant domestic aura or atmosphere as seen in a dream indicates spiritual approval of one's own effort to make life pleasant for others.

House (1st floor) - relates to one's everyday contacts in the physical world; also, to one's outer or objective consciousness life and of his way of thinking on the physical plane.

House (2^d floor) - relates to one's individuality or ego, as one thinks himself to be; also relates to one's secret vanities and use of his will.

House (3rd floor) - relates to the mind and its functioning as a vehicle of higher unconsciousness.

House (afire) - A house afire means consummation, purification and renunciation.

House (antique furnishings) (ark) - represents four planes of mind detained in old spiritual thoughts.

House (attic) - relates to one's pride and also to hidden resources yet to be seen, stemming from the soul-powers.

House (basement) - subconscious mind; residual karma yet to be resolved. (See pg. 346, p#3 for more info.)

House (bedroom) - a conjugal scene related to one's sex attitudes; also a scene of retirement from the clamors of the day.

House (bedroom from childhood) - a desire to return to security.

House (bedroom disorderly) - indicates emotional irresponsibility.

House (bedroom orderly) - bedrooms fragrant, clean, orderly, indicate one's attitude is balanced as to life, death and birth.

House (living room disordered) (ark) – a reminder that one must come under discipline when mingling with loved ones; one is mingling with irresponsible persons.

House (blue) - mental security.

House (brick) - one is a steward or shepherd of his physical and domestic life.

House (brown) - material prosperity.

House (ceiling) (ark) - spiritual perspective.

House (chimney) - the soul of the house.

House (dirty) - any form of soil, filth, or disorder seen in a house while dreaming is a reminder that one must come into discipline on all levels.

House (downstairs) - old karma from tribal or family genesis.

House (elevator for multiple floors) - means that one is exploring the many mansions of heaven or planes in the First Heaven and Second Heaven. In such dreams, one is usually accompanied by a presence which may be an angel, a night server or a Master.

House (empty) (ark) - ^ preparing for new experience; < insecurity.

House (fire on hearth) - indicates that the life of the body, or the house, is functioning as a living force.

House (golden yellow) - one is exploring the spiritual aspect of thought or wisdom.

House (hearth) - the hearth of a house indicates the Guardian Angel watching over the house.

(IS) - Guardian Angel.

House (inside entryway) - to be in an entry way inside the main door of the house means that one has been accepted as a disciple.

House (outside entryway) - to be in an entry way before the main door of the house means that one has yet to be accepted as a disciple.

House (familiar) - to repeatedly dream of a house familiar to oneself and to dream over and over of this same house indicates that one is researching his own emotions and desires, or that one is seeking to find his real self which inhabits the habitation of the soul.

House (new furnishings) (dc) - represents four planes of mind; born anew; new beginning; a state of grace.

House (no furniture) (ktk) - releasing and moving on from a level of mind that can manifest as outer change.

House (inside) - with a pleasant atmosphere denotes spiritual approval for one's efforts to make life pleasant for others. Also, a mark of grace and assurance that one is to bring his personal house into order.

House (living room) - special place for mingling with loved persons.

House (living room disordered) (ark) - one is mingling with irresponsible persons.

House (more than one living) - one is weighing or gauging his relationship in the family atom.

House (yellow mustard) (ark) - house of deception.

House (outside) - can represent the four bodies: the physical, etheric, emotional and mental.

House (painting inside) - spiritual approval for one's efforts to take on a new outlook (Note color to enhance interpretation on outlook.)

House (porch) - temporary plateau giving a new overlook; also indicates an invitation to enter in and to explore.

House (porch) coming up to - to dream of a person coming up to a porch means a new or unexpected event in the life of the person coming toward the porch.

House (purchasing) (ark) - acquiring a new outlook on four planes of mind.

House (red) - danger.

House (refurbishing) (ark) - one is overhauling old spiritual thoughts with new ones.

House (refurnishing) - one is replacing old spiritual thoughts with new ones.

House (repairs) (356) - if one is repairing something in a house or building, it indicates one is overhauling the outer world appearances and personality.

House (roof) - transcendental consciousness; *Kingdom of God*.¹² Symbolic of the mind, of covering for one's mental body. If in good repair, indicates one should enter into the calm of his omniscient mind or mind in Christ. A roof is also a symbol of the Father who is the covering for all -- both the physical father and the Father Divine.

House (roof top) - to dream of jumping off the roof top of a house indicates that one is returning to the physical body too abruptly.

House (stone) - one is secure in his trust.

House (study) - large room filled with books means research of the akasic records during sleep.

House (subdivisions) - subdivision of houses indicates that one has a lack of home consciousness, and that the family-atom security is being filtered out.

House (trailer) - symbolizes that one is living as an air plant with no roots emotionally or mentally.

House (unpainted) - neglect of stewardship.

House (white) - indicates stability, public recognition, purity in the outlook of home environments.

House (without walls) (ark) - indicates an openness to one's attitudes on life, death, and birth.

House (without windows) - indicates that one is self-engrossed, seeing materialistically only with the physical plane.

House (window) - a window in the house of a dream indicates that one has limited vision influenced and controlled by domestic situations.

House (yellow) (ark) - one is exploring the intellect.

Hummingbird - sustained alignment with the higher etheric body; a levitation expert of the mind.

Hunted (by tiger) - indicates that one is associated with a person who has a ruthless and cruel, tiger-like nature. In the dream he is being warned to fortify himself against cruel persons.

Hunting (an animal) - in a dream this indicates that one is tracking down and conquering his own traits corresponding to the animal.

Hunting (a lion) - the lion symbolizes the initiate's will. This reveals that one is tracking down and seeking to overcome his untrained sentient nature.

Hunting (a tiger) - one is being alerted that something in his nature is ruthless and tiger-like.

Husbandman (Gardener) - the Father in Heaven, the Caretaker of the spiritual garden. ¹³.¹⁴
